Our member-owners are not strangers to hard work, fighting the elements to produce food and energy for the nation and beyond. We are increasingly concerned with our Administration's Executive action power; permitting and taking permits away, completely eroding this sense of certainty for businesses who wish to invest in our country's future.

We have worked in good faith with TC Energy for several years. We have witnessed their care and concern for the landowners and community firsthand. TC Energy has committed to utilize only union labor to build the Keystone XL pipeline in the United States, resulting in up to 8,000 jobs and \$900 million in gross union wages in 2021 alone.
